INTRODUCTION:

In this 11-page INDEX, all items are in the same context. It’s what the Bible says the Church is, versus what is seen in today’s churches, and what Jesus is going to do about it. It also includes an interpretation of some key “*signs of the times*,” as Jesus labeled them. Presented is the Lord’s scriptural plan for Christianity in the very end-times. An important interpretational aid, discovered during the writing, is a set of teaching slides on The Sevenfold Structure of Christianity, presented below in Library-4.

The Libraries of this Alpha Aquila website contain three book-length manuscripts and a number of shorter related articles written over a period from 1995 to Date. They are categorized into groups, according to their placement in the online libraries. Each category is briefly described above its documents.

A new feature was added on June 20th, 2009, being a set of synopses of recent books, both Christian and secular. These synopses, when viewed jointly, give a unified interpretation of some particular signs of the times. They also provide a model for interpreting future signs. Creation of this feature dates from January, 2009, and marks a transition in the basic holdings of the libraries.

These documents, and making them freely available to readers, provide the motivation for this website.

This is a descriptive Index of all the PDF documents, listed by title, in Libraries-1 through -4. The INDEX seen in the website Navigation column is the file you are looking at, now.

LIBRARY-1

BOOKS/MANUSCRIPTS (Long):

These are book-length manuscripts, only one of which has been self-published. All are freely downloadable and usable under terms of the copyrights. Copying and printing of the manuscripts are allowed, but editing is prohibited in Adobe.

The Church in Transition (2007)

This 97-page manuscript (in First Draft form) is the follow-on to The Church Visited, which was self-published in 2002. This later manuscript resulted from prophetic reception of 84 scriptures in nine sets during the period 1998-2004. This set was dubbed the 'Post-'97 Impartations.' It fits hand-in-glove with a prior set of scriptures, dubbed Impartations-'97, which resulted in The Church Visited. This later set provides the 'how' of preparing the mature Church for ministry in the very end-times. It shows that the so-called Overcoming Church of the Book of Revelation shall operate in much the same form as the First-Century Church, and for the same reason, being governmental oppression. Together, both Impartations and resulting books give a complete view of the transition coming to the Church before Jesus returns.

The Church Visited (2002)

A 120-page manuscript of the book by the same name, published by Gazelle Press of Mobile, Alabama. ISBN 1-58169-093-2, 2002. This book resulted from prophetic receipt by a home church of 95 scriptures over a period of six months during 1997-98. Those ten sets were labeled 'Impartations-'97' by the home church. Each scripture set had a common context. The sets linked together in sequence, to make a story. The book was that story. It was a detailing of the future of the corporate Christian Church in what is biblically called The Day of the Lord. Jesus called it a day of Great Tribulation. The message of Impartations-'97 lays the scriptural foundation of 'what' and 'why' must occur in two phases to prepare the mature Church for ministry in a time of Great Tribulation and Great Harvest.

The Joshua Walk (1992)

A 129-page pattern (type) for the Christian walk, from faith to maturity, based on the walk of the ancient Israelites from Egyptian captivity to life in the Promised Land. A pattern for both the Christian individual and the corporate Church. A sequence of seventy Old Testament events that map over into New Testament events for the Christian. Shows seven progressive phases, named Faith, Truth, Spirituality, Power, Ministry, Doctrine, and Maturity. The basis for a subsequently developed seven-fold scriptural model for Christianity.

VISION DOCUMENTS (Short):

These documents comprise my personal testimony plus my vision for both the corporate Church and my personal ministry.

What Christianity Means to Me (19 February 2007)

A 4-page personal testimony about how God got the author's attention in 1984. What Christianity means to the author is a very personal relationship with Jesus, based on communication. Verbal communication. Two-way communication. Which is scriptural, of course.

A Living Vision (19 March 2006).

Twelve (12) pages. Every minister of Christ needs a corporate vision as well as an individual vision. The corporate vision is what God is doing in the Church at the time. The individual vision is how the minister's efforts fit the corporate vision. Different ministers may have differing corporate visions, and that's OK, in so far as

they all agree on the major points. And, that's because God doesn't give any one person the entire picture. That is so that His ministers will work together and share their corporate visions. This combination of corporate and individual visions is my own.

BOOK SYNOPSES (SHORT):

These synopses of one Christian book and several secular books provide views of the signs of our times from different vantage points. Taken together, they provide a multi-dimensional model for interpreting the signs of our very end-times.

Remnant, Restoration, and Revolution - Barna (12 April 2006).

A 4-page review of George Barna's 2005 book, Revolution. Connecting his book with the sevenfold Christian model. Barna's results as an interpretation of yet another sign of the very end-times.

Who We Are - Huntington (February 28th, 2009)

This 20-page paper is a reprise of the book, Who Are We?, by M.I.T. Professor Samuel J. Huntington, plus my connection of his results with the Bible. His voluminously documented work shows that not only has the United States been a Christian country, but it remains so, with recent polls showing that 84% of Americans claim to be Christian. His results also show that commencing in 1964-65, there has been an organized elitist effort to convince the U.S. citizenry otherwise. My scriptural research shows that the bible prophetically supports both of Huntington's results.

Surviving The New Depression - Weiss (April 29th, 2009)

This 16-page paper is a synopsis of the book, The Ultimate Depression Survival Guide, by Martin D. Weiss, Ph.D., of Weiss Research, Inc., in Jupiter Beach, FL. The book's principal thesis is that America (and the world) is heading into a second Great Depression, due to a buildup of inexorable financial forces that cannot be denied. Dr. Weiss gives a detailed factual documentation of how we got into this situation and what we personally have to do to survive it financially. This present paper describes the key results of Dr. Weiss' book. I include this synopsis here to show another aspect of the signs of our very end-times and to offer some survival actions that I, myself, am taking.

All But Us ? – Steyn (May 30th, 2009)

This 7-page paper is a synopsis of the book, America Alone, the End of the World as We Know It, by Mark Steyn. This book is a surprising political look at The Post-Christian West, being the formerly Christian Protestant Western Europe, plus Australia, New Zealand, and Canada. It shows that these nations have essentially committed cultural, if not national, suicide. That is because their birth rates have fallen well below replacement level, which is 2.11 babies per woman. Their falling populations will not long be able to sustain their Democratic-Socialist Welfare States, which they all are. The European West is now committing national suicide, since their Muslim populations, with their higher birth rates, are rapidly attaining voting equity with the non-Muslim population. Islam will soon take over the European West. Only one nation in the Christian West is not following this trend. That nation is the United States of America.

CBS' Bernie Goldberg, on TV Media Bias (July 27th, 2009).

This 6-page paper is a synopsis of the book, BIAS, by Bernard Goldberg. It fills a previously noticed gap in the emerging picture painted by the books previously synopsized. It describes the role of TV News (the three major networks plus PBS) in propagandizing and deceiving the American people by slanting cultural news reporting to the political left. As Goldberg says, "... *the only time they utter the words, "left-wing" is when they're talking about an airplane.*"

This is not an analytical book, such as Huntington's and Steyn's, but rather is anecdotal. However, Goldberg quotes many, many conversations with the CBS News President, Producers, night-Time News 'Stars', and other News notables. These conversations were about major cultural issues and how they are reported. He gives such quotes from CBS and the other major network News organizations.

Goldberg devotes a considerable amount of coverage to characterizing the 'elites' who form the bulk of the TV News Reporters. He surprisingly reports that they do not slant the news to conform to a particular brand of politics, but to conform to a particular worldview they all share. He also gives reasons why he does not think this is a conspiracy, at least in the legal sense. This characterization puts a face on those 'elites' that Huntington previously identified as the 'coalition' attempting to deconstruct America. They have also been identified in the book, The Real Lincoln, listed just below.

The Real Lincoln - DiLorenzo (July 20th, 2009)

This 5-page paper is a synopsis of the book, The Real Lincoln, by Thomas J. DiLorenzo, a Professor of Economics at Loyola College of Maryland. This is an extraordinary book that undoes revisionist histories that have contributed to the myth of Lincoln. What DiLorenzo does is show what really started the Civil War, and it wasn't about freeing the slaves. It was about radically transforming the form of government given to us by the Founding Fathers. The South objected. The South lost. And, so the form of Executive Branch of the federal government that Lincoln set up has propagated down to us, and is a source of many of our present problems. This book is a key element in our ability to interpret the signs of our times.

Christianity's Dangerous Idea – McGrath (June 11th, 2010)

This 12-page paper is a synopsis of the 2007 book, Christianity's Dangerous Idea, by Alister McGrath. Dr. McGrath is a Professor of Historical Theology at Oxford University. This book fills in the details of the Christian 'surprise' discovered in previous books in this synopsis series. It supports in great detail the view previously developed that the United States is all about Christianity and always was. Dr. McGrath examines the history of the Christian Protestant Reformation and the subsequent continuing development of Protestantism in colonial America and the subsequent United States. The dangerous idea was not the Reformation, itself, but the implications of Luther's and Calvin's ideas that would change the nature of the relationship between the individual Protestant and both the Church and the State. These ideas would be extremely important in the relationship between citizen and national government in the founding of the United States, some 250 years later. It would be a relation that got the government out of the Church, but not vice-versa.

THE LIBRARY

The Liberal Mind – Rossiter (July 5th, 2010)

This 12-page paper is a synopsis of the 2006 book, The Liberal Mind: The Psychological Causes of Political Madness, by Lyle Rossiter, M.D. Dr. Rossiter is a forensic psychiatrist, with 40 years experience diagnosing personality disorders. He shows persuasively that the thought processes of the average liberal are, in fact, a mental disorder. In psychological terms, it's a neurosis, springing from trauma in the liberal's familial relationships during the development of his personality. It is a transference neurosis, in that it incorporates the unconscious projections of early childhood psychodynamics into the political arenas of adult life. It is the result of a failure to be trained in the basic psychodynamic elements of an adult, competent to live in a society of ordered liberty. This book gives a good foundation for understanding the apparent 'craziness' of current liberal acts proceeding from the U.S. government.

Walking With God – Eldredge (April 26th, 2011)

This 6-page paper is a synopsis of the 2008 book, Walking With God, by John Eldredge. He tells the story of a year of his life, wherein he learned how to talk to God and to hear His replies. His analysis of that year provides a wealth of information about how God can heal a Christian's mind. It also shows the measures of spiritual warfare necessary, to combat demonic third parties that will also try to speak to the Christian. Eldredge discovers what God's purposes are, in these types of verbal encounters. The value of this book in the context of the present writings is that it also adds to the Christian's abilities to interpret the signs of our times.

The Battle for America – (August 29th, 2009; Updated May 2nd, 2011)

This 39-page paper is based on books by Huntington, Steyn, Goldberg, DiLorenzo, Herrnstein & Murray, Weiss, Barna, McGrath, Rossiter, Eldredge, and the Bible, all taken together. It puts together a broad picture of where America is politically, how it got there, where it is going, and what it will do when it gets there. It shows the biblical role of Christianity in America, and vice-versa, which has been continuously in effect since 1620. It provides a basis for Christians to be able to interpret the signs of our times, as described in the paper next below..

Interpreting Our Signs of the Times (Updated After Each Synopsis)

This 20-page paper integrates the previous papers, to obtain a multidimensional view of the signs of our times. It then provides a model of frames for interpreting future signs. The frames are ways of looking at events, plus the events, themselves.

LIBRARY-2

GOING ON TO COMPLETION:

Concerning the completion of Jesus' restorational task for the Church, to be completed prior to His second physical advent.

The Sixth Move – A Summary (15 January 2009)

This 21-page writing pulls together in a summary the connected topics of the Alpha Aquila website. It is an attempt to summarize in one place the picture of what the website is about. It is the recommended first reading for new viewers of the website, to show them whether or not they are interested in further reading. It does not show the organization of the documents on the website, which is what this present INDEX does.

An Engineer Looks at Rebuilding the Church (23 January 2008)

This 7-page writing was motivated by a 2007 book by Andrew Strom on the so-called ‘prophetic movement.’ This present writing integrates Strom’s ‘Great Revival’ concept with the whole Bible that prophesies such an event in the very end-times. This writing gives the scriptural details of how the last Great Revival shall happen.

Going on to Completion – A Course Outline (23 December 2005).

Here is a 6-page outline for a scripture-based course to train Christians about ministry in the Great Tribulation. Completion is what the Bible is all about and it is what the very end-times are all about. It will be accomplished on Earth in God’s way. More than 100 references.

Grasping the Transition (Updated 01 August, 2010).

This 10-page writing incorporates and replaces the previous 2-page writing, entitled, A Transition in Focus, dated January 7th, 1998. The present paper integrates descriptions of the restorative end-times transition in Christianity, as covered in several of my different writings. The purpose of this paper is to come up with a short characterization of the Transition, by which the reader may immediately grasp what it is. A key new element of the character of the Transition is that it is primarily an event that originates in the United States, just as the Charismatic and Pentecostal movements in Christianity, before it. It incorporates the viewpoint that the U.S. is the ‘Last Man Standing’ in what is now the Post-Christian West.

Crossing Jordan – God’s Sixth Move of Restoration. (4 Nov. 1995).

A 15-page picture of God’s sixth (transitional) move, of seven, of restoration of the modern Church, taken from the Book of Joshua. This is the move that prepares the Church for the victorious combat of The Great Tribulation. The move is in fifteen parts, corresponding to the sevenfold model of Christianity, which is detailed in one of the later writings. This writing documented the writer’s discovery of the scriptural 7-element model of the Christian Church.

Going Beyond Six – Great Tribulation Communication (14 Oct. 2014)

This 22-page writing is an amplified view of God’s sixth move of restoration of the modern Church. This view focuses on the communication of God’s very end-times prophets with the body of the Church. These prophets play a corporate role of the Elijah type, just prior to a corporate appearance of Jesus in the very end-times Church. This is before His individual second coming in the Rapture. His corporate appearance is a second manifestation of the Elisha type. This writing looks in detail at various biblical types applying to communication in the very end-times. It is this writer’s opinion that increasing communication is a sign of the very end-times.

GREAT TRIBULATION:

Concerning the relation between the so-called Rapture and what Jesus labeled as the Great Tribulation.

The Rapture Sequence (19 January 2006).

Three (3) pages. Uses three scriptures to show that a “Pre-Tribulation Rapture” is bad doctrine. Christians cannot be prepared for the Great Tribulation if they think they won’t be here for it.

Interpreting the Signs of the Times (Updated July 28th, 2010).

A 19-page scriptural understanding of today’s world and where it is headed. The Earthly judgment is on both Church and world, with the Church judgment happening first. Connection with God’s grace and the Great Harvest.

The Only Sign Given (21 February 2006).

Eight (8) pages. Looking for miraculous signs. What Jesus said about it. Look for the sign that He said would be given.

LIBRARY-3

THE PROPHETIC:

Concerning ‘The Prophetic’ and its role in the very end-times Church.

The Seven Ministries of the Prophet (15 March 1997).

With co-author, Froukje Eibrinks Jansen of the Netherlands, this 8-page writing describes seven prophetic ministries that match the sevenfold Christian model. Froukje had the ministries, and I had the model. Six references to books of the early ‘90s.

‘Office’ Versus ‘Practice’ in Church Ministry (26 November 2009)

Updated from previously entitled “The Office of the Prophet” (23 Oct. 2001).

A 3-page update of a previous article dealing with the question of whether or not a prophetic ministry in a church is an ‘office.’ Shows that in Scripture none of the five-fold ministries of [Eph. 4:11] are offices in some vertical authority structure. Rather, according to biblical Greek usage, they are functional ‘practices’, in the sense of a medical doctor or lawyer. And, each practice springs from a minister’s Romans-12 gifting. None of these five practices outrank one another. In terms of local church governance, the first-century scriptural norm was a ‘set man’ plus a body of elders. The ‘set man’ could be any of the five-fold ministers, so long as he possessed the heart of a shepherd (which, in fact, all need). Because a five-fold minister is highly gifted does not mean that he or she occupies some authoritative office in the church.

Who Shall Sound the Trumpet (21 October 2002).

An 8-page examination of where the Church is in its transitional preparation for operations during the Great Tribulation. Uses the results of Impartations-97 and the book, The Church Visited. Notes the parallelism with David Wilkerson’s 1985 book,

Set the Trumpet to Thy Mouth. Applies the sevenfold Church model to define the preparational steps.

End-Times Christian Prophets (21 July 2005)

Eight (8) pages. God's prophets are, not were. In the very end-times, the prophets have one last job, before Jesus collects His Church in what has been called the 'Rapture.' This is the same job prophets have had before, as in the Old Testament Elijah and his New Testament manifestation, John the Baptist. And, that job is to prepare the way for Jesus' corporate appearance (*phaneroo*) in the Body of Christ, before the Rapture. This time, 'Elijah' will also be corporate. This 7-page writing, plus 3-page Appendix, makes this case, scripturally.

The Elijah Factor (23 September 2009)

This 12-page paper is to pack as few words as possible into a description of the idea key to understanding very end-times Christianity. That idea is the third manifestation of the 'Elijah' Ministry. This time it is to restore Christianity in preparation for Jesus' second physical advent. It will perform that restoration in conjunction with the prophesied spiritual appearance (Gk.-*phaneroo*) of Jesus before His return (Gk.-*parousia*). This top-level paper is to allow readers to quickly decide if they wish to read more detailed handling of the subject in companion papers and manuscripts.

HEARING JESUS:

Concerning the communicational aspect of a Christian's personal relationship with Jesus. Some personal testimony.

The Four Most Terrible Words in the Bible (09 July 2010).

This is a simple 1-page explanation of what is explored in greater depth in the following two papers. It starts with Jesus' words in [Mat. 7:23], which show that there are some who think they are Christians, who will not be admitted to the Kingdom of Heaven. The four most terrible words are Jesus' phrase, " ... *I never knew you* ...", in explanation of why some are not admitted. The paper then shows the counter to that event, which is Jesus' words in [John 10:27]. There, Jesus says that He knows those who acoustically hear his phonetic voice. The Old Testament further clarifies this as a "still small voice" like a gentle breeze [1 Ki. 19:12-13]. This 'hearing' opens the door to a Christian's getting into the Kingdom of Heaven.

Conscience as Voice (27 January 2006).

Nine (9) pages. Hearing Jesus via the conscience. Scriptural 'psychology,' which is a Greek word, meaning 'soul-expression.' Diagramming the scriptural body, soul, and spirit.

Earnest Expectation (28 July 2005)

Four (4) pages. Anybody can talk to Jesus. That's called prayer. But, can anybody hear Jesus' answer as a phonetic voice in the head. The answer is "yes." And, the key is expecting it, earnestly, as an act of faith. This 4-page writing makes the scriptural case. It also scripturally covers possible deception by other, demonic, 'little

voices' in the head. As one might expect, this is one aspect of the personal relationship between the Christian Believer and Jesus.

A Book on Hearing Jesus (2008)

This is a second reference to the book by John Eldredge, entitled, Walking With God. That book is all about hearing God, ... in your native tongue. It is in the synopses, described above. Eldredge's book goes right along with the three papers, referenced just above.

WORSHIP:

Concerning what worship was in the early Church, what it is now, and what it can be.

True Worship (23 February 2006).

A 3-page scriptural examination of what God intends worship to be. It is simple. It is not complicated at all. It is man who complicates worship. If you want a scriptural picture of it, think of a faithful hound, licking his master's hand in adoration. This 3-page writing defines worship from what is written about it in the Bible. It clarifies what is meant by worshiping in spirit and in truth. It also characterizes false worship.

Teaching as Worship (25 July 2004)

Two (2) pages. Worship can be defined as being fed. But, can feeding be defined as worship? The Bible says so. This interpretation is based on Deuteronomy 12, together with what Paul told the elders at Ephesus in Acts 20. The ancient teaching and worship practices of the Christian Church are compared to those of the present day in this 2-page offering.

SPIRITUAL WARFARE:

Concerning why bad things happen to good people.

Surviving Christian Testing and Affliction (October 2006)

This 14-page writing deals extensively with the scriptural foundation for understanding tribulation in the individual Christian's life, and what to do about it. It examines how God's people can be individually subject to demonic oppression of mind or body, as were Paul and Job. It relates such oppression to God's chastisement of His sons and daughters. A byproduct is training to minister to afflicted Christianity during the very end-times. It gives very specific steps in diagnosing and resisting demonic oppression, if such is in the will of God. This is perhaps the most useful 'how-to-do-it' writing of the present series

LIBRARY-4

CONDENSED BOOK OULINES:

God's Scriptural Plan for the End-Times Church (18 April 2008)

A 3-page outline of god's plan for the very end-times corporate Church, as documented in the Bible. The corporate Church is also called the Body of Christ. This

plan was only apprehended by this writer as a result of God's revelation of what I called Impartations-'97 and the Post-'97 Impartations, which are documented in other of these series of writings. Impartations-'97 comprised the 'What' and 'Why' of God's plan, while the Post-'97 Impartations comprised the 'How.' This outline underlies the writing of two book-length manuscripts, the first of which was self-published in 2002.

Preparing Christianity for the Great Tribulation (May 2006).

Eight (8) pages. Puts together both Impartations '97 and the Post-'97 Impartations, to get a picture of the whole story of God's restoration of the Church. One paragraph descriptions of all nineteen of the impartations, plus a Synopsis up front and a Conclusion. Gives nine "Jesus Essentials" and three "Rapture Essentials" up front.

SEVEN-FOLD CHRISTIANITY:

These short writings are associated with the fundamental seven-fold model of Christianity that is a foundational aspect of the books.

The Sevenfold Structure of Christianity (14 April 2004).

An 8-page detailed specification of the sevenfold model of Christianity. It is a model that applies to both individual and corporate Christianity, in terms of both structure and process (the walk). The basic contexts are FAITH, TRUTH, SPIRIT, POWER, MINISTRY, DOCTRINE, and MATURITY. Eighteen sevenfold parameters are scripturally specified for each context. It was these eighteen that led to the model, via the hermeneutical spiral principle of scriptural interpretation. That is, the model is a seven-dimensional 'fit' in eighteen parameters.

The Sevenfold Christian Model (26 January 2009)

A set of 37 slides (from PowerPoint) for teaching the sevenfold structure and process of Christianity. The slides are totally scripture-based. These slides actually define what the sevenfold structure and process is, in terms of seven contexts, FAITH, TRUTH, SPIRIT, POWER, MINISTRY, DOCTRINE, AND MATURITY. The definition takes place from all the scripture sets, via the Hermeneutical Spiral process of Bible interpretation. The slides are amenable to individual self-teaching, without being used in a formal setting.

Vision of a Balanced Congregation (2 March 2000).

A 1-page description of what a congregation would look like if it displayed all the elements of the sevenfold Christian model.

Romans-12 Gifts Test (EXCEL™) – Self-Grading (13 April 2004)

This is a 5-page, 70-question test that reveals which of the seven 'grace' gifts of Romans 12:6-8 you have, and to what extent. It numerically evaluates your gifts on a scale from 0 to 5. The test originated with the Bill Gothard Ministries. When executed in Microsoft Excel™, it is self-grading.

The Three Wills of God (19 September 2003).

Two (2) pages on God's intentional, permissive, and ultimate wills, which accommodate His gift of free will to Man. Follows several other authors' writings on the subject. Motivated by the need to see that God's Great Tribulation plan for the churches and the Church is indeed part of His ultimate will.
